What I Do:

I graduated from University of Birmingham Medical School in 1997 and undertook training in general ear, nose and throat surgery in the West Midlands. I then undertook 18 months of advanced clinical fellowships in sinus and skull base surgery in Nottingham and South Africa, and then 3 months in internationally acclaimed centres in America, Germany and Switzerland.

Most of my clinical work is for patients needing complex and revision nose and sinus surgery including surgery to the skull base and brain through the nose using an endoscope. All this is done using a computer image guidance system in theatre similar to GPS in a car. I also carry out nose reshaping (rhinoplasty) usually after trauma.

I completed my PhD in January 2013 investigating chronic sinus disease
